SF Fire Proud to Support San Francisco Firefighters Local 798 Annual Toy Program this Holiday Season

The holiday season in San Francisco is a magical time of year. From decorative gingerbread houses and the sound of cable cars ringing, to ice skating in Union Square and the music of children carolers — the holiday spirit is present everywhere. SF Fire is proud to continue its support of the San Francisco Firefighters Local 798 Toy Program, the city's largest and the nation's oldest event of its kind and run entirely on the generosity of donations. Each year, stations around the city collect toys for underprivileged children so that their holidays may be a little brighter.

Volunteers organize and distribute unwrapped toys, games, books, sports equipment and other must-have items on the wish list of children throughout our community. Highlights are the beloved Crucible and Toy trucks that will be decorated in holiday lights and visit neighborhoods throughout the city in December.

"San Francisco is a very prosperous community, yet every year thousands of children throughout the city might otherwise go without a toy under their tree if it wasn't for the generosity of our supporters," said Mike Guajardo, SFFD Lieutenant at Engine 42 and Director of the Local 798 Toy Program. "This year, we



hope to see volunteerism return to pre-pandemic levels – whether it's more corporate sponsors like SF Fire Credit Union or a younger generation of active firefighters or the return of students from the SF City College Fire Academy where volunteering is part of their curriculum. This program brings a spirit of community when you volunteer alongside colleagues, classmates, neighbors and friends by helping people in need during the holidays."

Every year, more than 300 firefighters and friends volunteer their time to distribute over 200,000 toys to more than 40,000 disadvantaged children through the Toy Program.

SF Fire will contribute to the cause in a variety of ways. In addition

to countless hours of staff volunteer time, SF Fire will donate more than \$25,000 in toys and sponsorship of signature events like the 17th Annual SFFD Chili Cook-off, the Local 798 Charity Basketball Tournament, and the SF Firefighters Toy Program Golf Tournament. Additionally, toy collection barrels will be placed in all our branches to encourage the community to donate an unwrapped toy at any of our locations.
